## Paint Disposal

Latex paint is non-hazardous, and it can be disposed of as a solid with your regular trash when it becomes solid. Never dispose of liquid paints in your trash. Several methods to properly solidify latex paint are listed below:

- Remove the lid and let the paint dry out in the can. This works best when an inch or less of paint is left in the can and is most effective in warmer months.
- For larger volumes of latex paint, line a cardboard box with a plastic bag. Add an absorbing agent such as kitty litter, sawdust, sand, or shredded newspaper to the box. Pour the paint into the box so that it forms a thin layer (about 1 inch deep) and allow the paint to harden. Repeat this process until all of the paint has hardened.
